V4.1.1p1 Release Notes

Upgrade Note:

This version supports direct upgrade from v4.0.5p2 and later versions.

This release mainly focuses on bug fixes and option optimizations, with no new features added

Bug Fixes:

1. Fixed an issue in [Telephony → Preferences → Global PBX Settings] where disabling Call Waiting caused Call Forward on Busy to become ineffective.
2. Fixed an issue in [System → Security Center → Firewall] where firewall priority calculation was incorrect.
3. Fixed an issue in [Reports → Records → OneTouch Recording] where the date parameter was invalid when searching by date.
4. Fixed an issue in [Reports → Log → Call Log] where no call record was generated when an inbound FXO call to a department was not answered.
5. Fixed an issue in [Telephony → Outbound Control → Trunks] where saving IAX trunk data resulted in an error.
6. Fixed an issue where MP3 playback volume was too low when played via the operator console.
7. Fixed an issue in [Reports → Log → Call Log] where the call status was incorrect when a call came in via trunk → IVR → extension and was not answered.
8. Fixed an issue in [Telephony → Preferences → Global PBX Settings] where an excessively large extension range caused system freezing and limited extension numbers to 3 digits.

Optimizations:

1. In [Addons → Remote Access → Settings], customer information fields now disallow special characters (= " '\ # ; []).
2. Adjusted the playback timing of the voice assistant invalid prompt tone, now played once before hang-up.
3. Optimized the log cleanup script to automatically clear logs daily and prevent storage from being filled.
4. Optimized the daemon process to avoid startup failures.
5. Optimized the data transmission logic during active/standby switchover to ensure extensions come online immediately.
6. Added extension username configuration support in the Hotel API.
